Our members are also as geographically diverse as the Chicago metropolitan area itself, with members working throughout northern and southern Illinois, Indiana and Wisconsin.

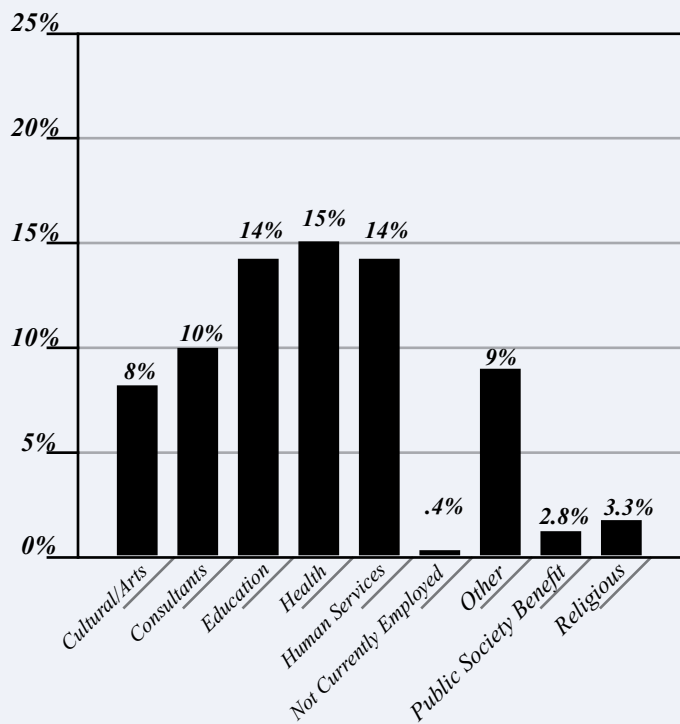

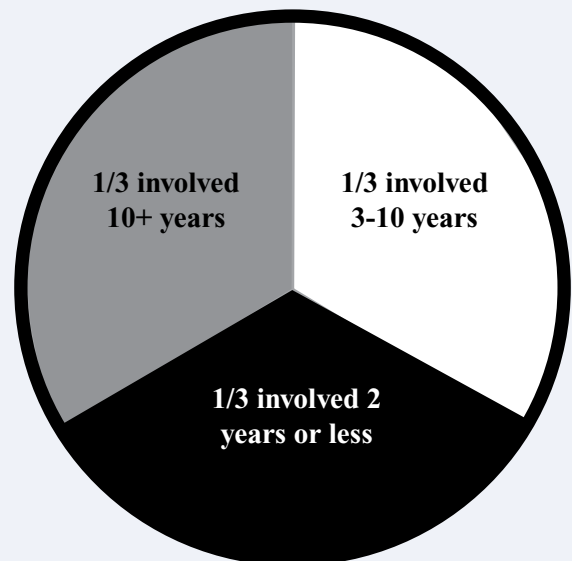
Member Organization Type
