Greg Cameron joined WTTW in April 2008 as Executive Vice President and Chief Development Officer. His responsibilities include managing and directing revenue and sales divisions of WWCI, including national and local program marketing, television and radio fundraising and sales, development, and communications.

Cameron, a resident of Chicago, has served as the Deputy Director and Chief Development Officer at the Museum of Contemporary Art in Chicago since July 2000. Prior to that, he held the position of Chief Development Officer, in addition to several key positions in the development office. From 1994-97, he served as the Director of Foundation and Corporate Relations at the Art Institute of Chicago, and as Development Coordinator at the City of Chicago Department of Cultural Affairs from 1986-88. A board member of the Illinois Arts Alliance, the Greater North Michigan Avenue Association, and the University of Chicago Children's Hospital Friends against AIDS, Cameron also serves on various strategy and fundraising committees at other cultural organizations such as the Center on Halsted, the Free Street Theater, About Face Theatre, and the School of the Art Institute. He currently teaches arts management as an Associate Professor at the University of Illinois at Chicago.
