Aspire coffees are now sold in all Chicagoland Whole Foods stores and were featured nationally on the TODAY Show.

Jim's prior nonprofit roles include Chief Executive Officer of Big Brothers Big Sisters of Lake County (IL) and Director of Communications for the United Way of Metropolitan Chicago, one of the nation's largest United Ways.
