If they are not a member, the nomination must be endorsed by a current AFP Chicago chapter member.

Presentation of Awards

The honorees selected will receive their awards at the 39th Annual Philanthropy Awards Luncheon May 1, 2015. Honorees will be notified of their selection by December 10, 2014. Honorees <u>must</u> be present to receive awards. AFP Philanthropy Awards are not bestowed posthumously.
