David Cashman has more than 13 years of experience in higher education development and is currently Senior Director, International Advancement for the University of Chicago. In this capacity he leads a team to increase philanthropic support of the University from alumni, parents, friends and organizations in key markets outside the U.S. In addition he helps implement a coordinated program of activities which expand the University's international fundraising capacity globally. From January 2013 to April 2015, he was Director of International Advancement-Asia, with a focus on India and China and, since April 2015, his work includes oversight of global advancement initiatives.

Prior to this, Cashman spent 8 years at Chicago Booth, most recently as Senior Associate Director for Alumni Affairs and Development where he served as principal relationship manager for the dean's advisory boards, including cabinets in Asia, Central/South America, and Europe/Middle East. He managed a portfolio of high-capacity individuals in support of fundraising and alumni engagement goals globally, helped establish the school's first Global Advisory Board, and managed global board recruiting.

Cashman has an M.B.A. from Chicago Booth, a master's degree in social science from the University of Chicago, and a bachelor's degree in history from Boston College.
