Chris Hensley is the President of the Cadence Health Foundation, where he is responsible for the vision, planning, implementation and management of philanthropic activities and fundraising programs for Cadence Health. Mr. Hensley has been serving the organization since 2012, and his career includes extensive leadership and management experience in non-profit, government and healthcare environments.

Prior to joining Cadence Health, Mr. Hensley was regional vice president of the American Cancer Society, where he served as a member of the Illinois division leadership team, with responsibility for developing strategies and executing the organization's mission.
