

## ANGEL GUTIERREZ

Angel Gutierrez serves as the Vice President of Institutional Advancement for Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Chicago, where he leads a Department of 23 staff who are collectively responsible for planning, developing, and implementing the overarching fundraising strategy for the organization. In his fifteen months he and his team have raised a record \$52 million.

Angel has more than 25 years of executive leadership, financial, operational, and program development experience in health and human service nonprofit agencies. He also serves as co-chair of the Hispanic Heritage Fund (Nuestro Futuro) of the Chicago Community Trust; and served as chair of the Board of Directors of the Rauner Family YMCA for four years. He has participated on various State and Federal committees and work-groups, addressing such issues as public/private funding and partnerships, childhood hunger, and equitable program access for low-income communities.

A native Chicagoan, Angel was named the 2013 Latino Professional of the Year by the Chicago Latino Network, and that year also received the annual Community Service Award from the Rauner YMCA. He holds a master's degree in Public Administration from Roosevelt University, and a bachelor's degree in Political Science from Loyola University.
